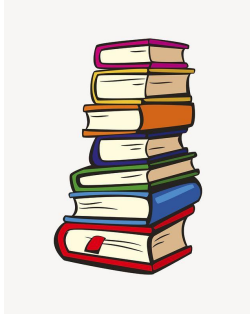

*(With the exception of any delays).*

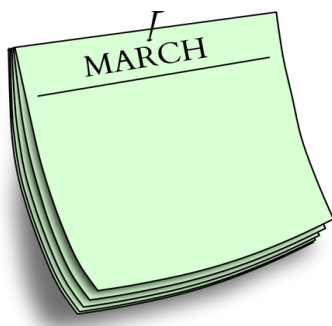
A text will be sent to parents over the break to keep you all updated.
